For anyone who is looking at a Nene & Ouse Trip Guide for the first time, this is your community transport and we welcome new members. Nene & Ouse is a 'Door to Door' 'Ring & Ride' Bus Service. Once you have signed up to become a member you simply call us to book any outing shown in the Trip Guide. We then give a collection time the day before your trip. You will be picked up from your front door at the allotted time and returned to your door at the end of the trip. Bookings need to be made 48 hours prior to departure of a trip.

If you intend to take a walking frame or shopping trolley on a Trip please advise the Office. We need to allocate space for these items. We do not carry scooters on our buses.

Members are welcome to take a companion with them on 2 Trips per annum.

To date we have to some degree waived Carer's fares, we will continue to waive the joining fee but will require payment of fares. We are a small Charity for which funding is a constant issue and as such we are unable to provide a free service.

Stratford Upon Avon

Stratford-upon-Avon is a town, small in size but large in history and interest. The streets themselves hold a thousand delights with the chemistry of the ages mixed in with the needs of today. The layout of the town is based on a medieval cross system and therefore finding your way around is relatively easy. The town sits proudly on the River Avon which flows through the middle of town, once a key factor as trade route and enhanced by linking with the British Waterways Canal network for the Midlands, the River is now used mainly for leisure activities. The focal point for many on the River Avon is the facade of The Royal Shakespeare Theatre.

William Shakespeare's significance to the town can be found in his families' houses, three of which are situated within easy walking distance within town, the other two situated slightly out of town with easy access.
